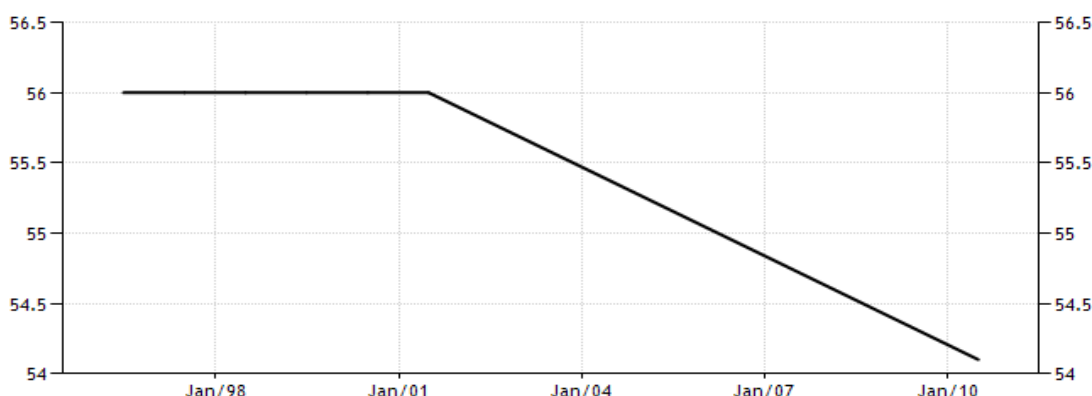

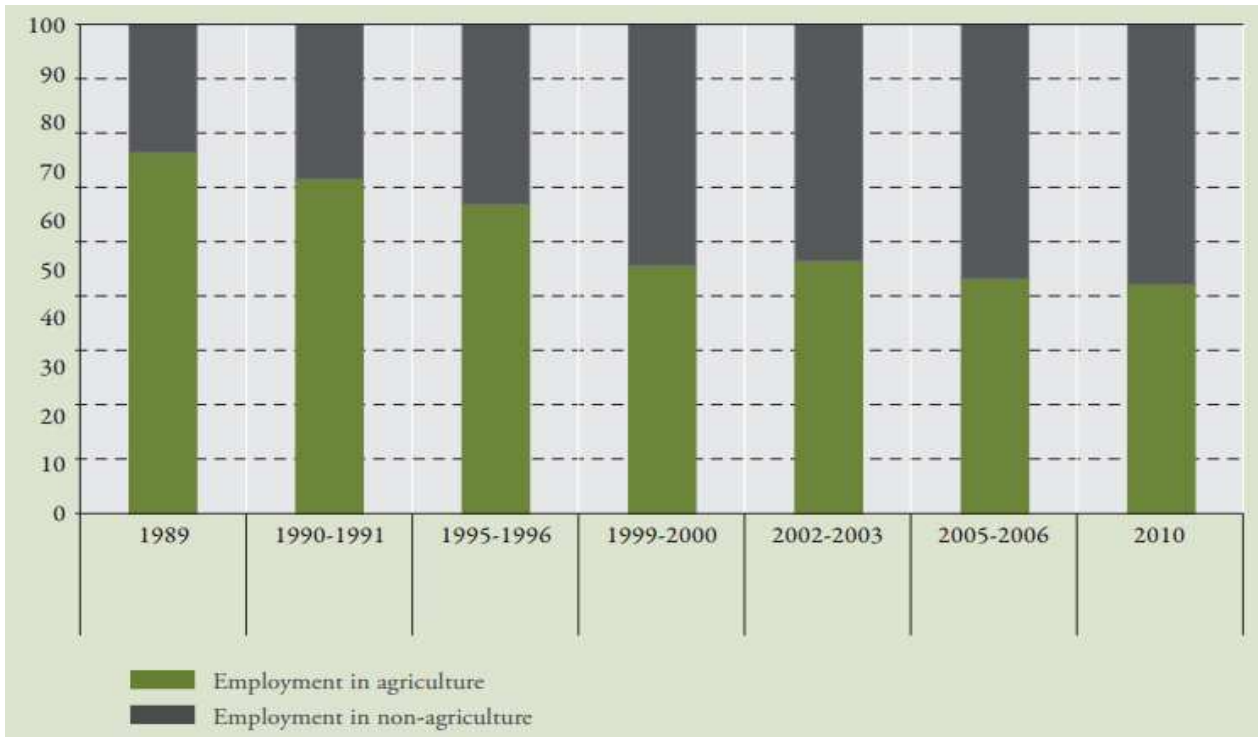

### Employed Persons, 1995 - 2015



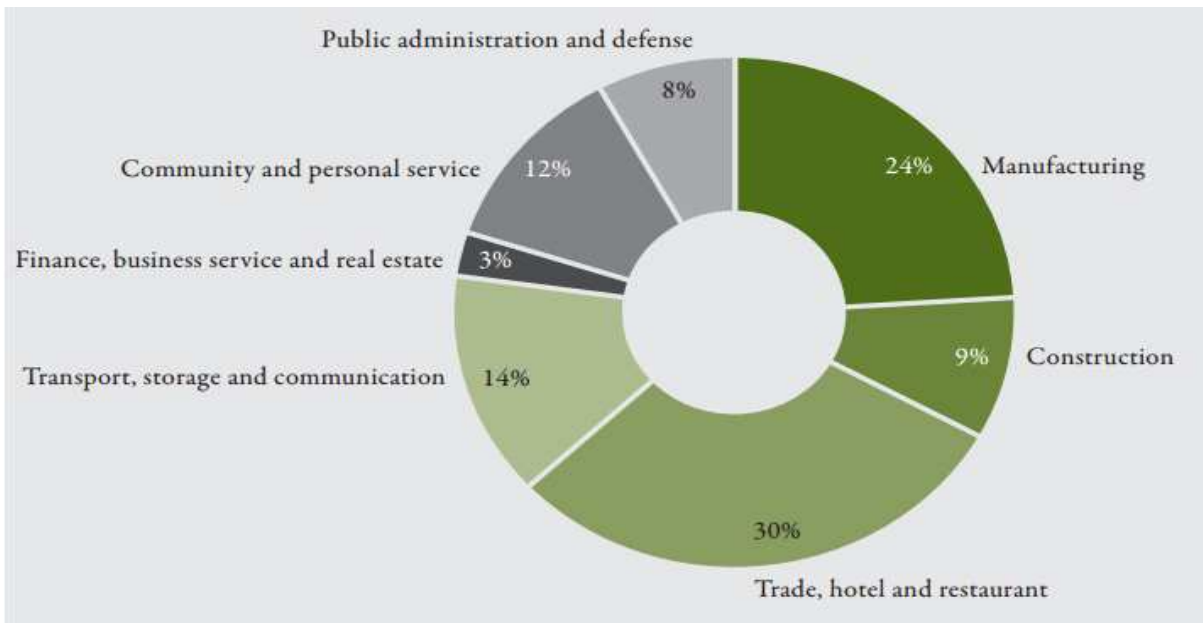

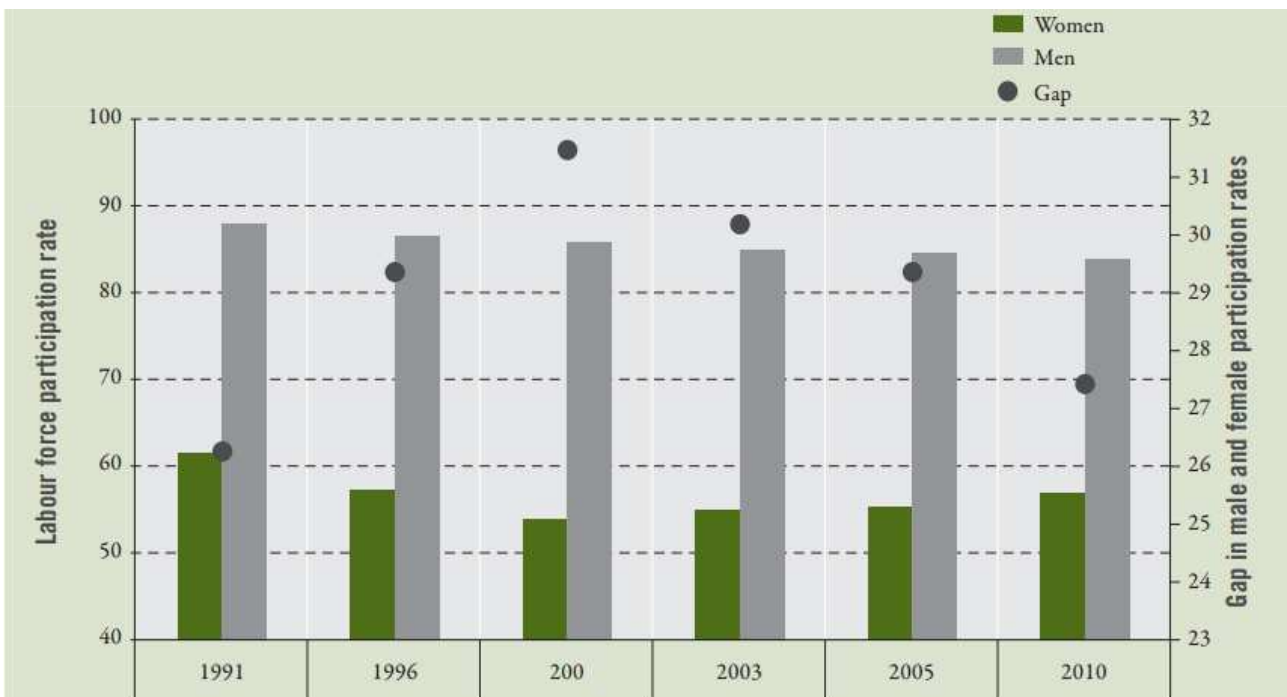

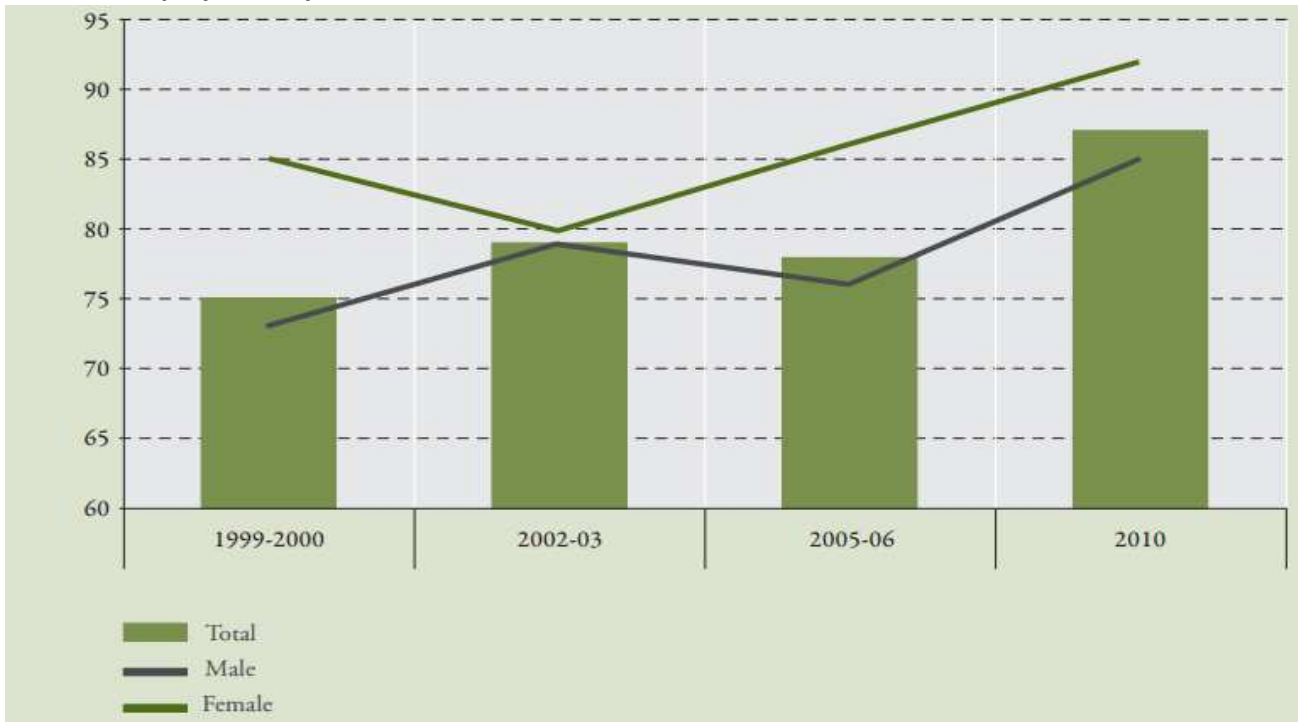
